

New Champions Crowned at 2025 Freestyle Trampoline World Championships in Barcelona

Barcelona, Spain — September 2025 — The 2025 Freestyle Trampoline (FTA) World Championships, held as part of the Extreme Barcelona Action Sports Festival at the iconic Parc del Fòrum from **September 5–7, 2025**, brought together the world's best freestyle athletes for a breathtaking weekend of innovation, creativity, and athleticism. The event featured **over 90 athletes from 21 countries**, thrilling record-breaking crowds of over 300 in the stands and **32,000+** fans attendign the Extreme Barcelona event.
